Those books will then be placed at the foot of the altar during all of our November Masses.

New Cardinal

Pope Francis has elevated the Most Rev. Francis Leo, Archbishop of Toronto, to the College of Cardinals. The Consistory will take place in Vatican City on Dec. 8, 2024.

Most Rev. Archbishop Leo was named as the Archbishop of Toronto of 2023 replacing Most Rev. Cardinal Thomas Collins. With this appointment, Canada will now have five Cardinals. Prior to his appointment as Archbishop of Toronto, Archbishop Leo was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Montreal on July 16th, 2022.
