Month of October: Holy Rosary Devotion

October is the Month of the Holy Rosary. The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the sign of the Cross and follows with the Apostles' Creed, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. When we pray the Rosary, we ask Mary to intercede for us as we seek to draw closer to her Son, Jesus, by meditating on His life, death, and Resurrection.

Truth and Reconciliation

September 30 every year is Canada's National Day for Truth and Reconciliation which honors Residential School Survivors and the children who never returned home, plus their families, and communities. We here at Lac Ste Anne parish observe this day on the closest Sunday to September 30th, which this year is September 29th. Today after Mass we will hear from a special speaker and after Mass we will move out to the oak tree that we planted several years ago for a short ceremony which will mark this day. Afterward we will celebrate with coffee and cookies.

Food Bank

During the month of October, the month when we all celebrate Thanksgiving and harvest time, our parish holds a food bank drive. If you are able, we are asking for donations of non-perishable foods

any time throughout October. Donations can be brought either on Sundays or when weekday Masses are being held, Tuesday at 7pm and Wednesday at 9:00am. and during office hours, Wednesdays between 10am and 3pm. Be assured that your donations really are greatly appreciated.

Priorities for the Next Three Years



As is outlined in the hand out that has been available in the last three weeks in the foyer, our diocese is launching a program of pastoral priorities for the next 3 years. This program will help us to deepen our knowledge of our faith and relationship with Christ.

This year 2024/2025 in our Parish we will deepen the meaning of the Eucharist. Before Mass on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month, we will have commentaries focusing on the Eucharist.
